

EIGHTY - SIXTH ANNUAL CITY MEETING WARNING

March 3, 2009

The legal voters of Winooski are hereby warned and notified to meet at the Senior Citizens Center on Barlow Street.

The polling hours at the above described voting districts are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Voting is by Australian Ballot. The legal voters of the City of Winooski are further notified that voter qualification, registration and absentee voting relative to said meeting shall be as provided in Chapters 43, 51 and 55 of Title 17, Vermont Statutes Annotated.

ARTICLE ONE:

To elect a Mayor for a term of two (2) years.

ARTICLE TWO:

To elect two (2) City Councilors for a term of two (2) years each.

ARTICLE THREE:

To elect a Champlain Water District Representative for a term of three (3) years.

ARTICLE FOUR:

Shall the voters of the City of Winooski vote to approve the General Fund Budget of Five Million, Seven Hundred Fifty-five Thousand, Eighty-five Dollars (\$5,755,085) for the fiscal year July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010?

The amount to be raised from property taxes is Three Million, Nine Hundred Seventy-three Thousand, Eight Hundred Fifteen Dollars (\$3,973,815).

ARTICLE FIVE:

Shall the City Council be authorized to apply for and accept funds from sources other than property taxation, and to expend the same for the benefit of the City in addition to sums for which budget appropriation has been made? (Approval of this article will not impact property taxes.)

ARTICLE SIX:

Shall the City Council be authorized to create separate enterprise fund budgets to account for the deposit and expenditure of water system, sewer system and parking garage revenue from sources other than property taxation? (Approval of this article will not impact property taxes.)

ARTICLE SEVEN:

To do any other business proper when met.
