Basic Description:

Teachers are responsible for planning and leading club activities 2 times/wk, planning and leading 1 thematic lesson in a designated specialty area 4 times/wk, leading small group reading activities 4 times/wk, and organizing small group meetings 5 times/wk. They work under the direct supervision of the Head Teacher.
