GARDEN RULES AND ETIQUETTE:

Keep the Garden Clean

- Pack all trash out with you when you leave
- Place all dead disease-free plants and vegetable scraps in the compost

No Chemical Pest Killers or Non-organic Fertilizers eg Miracle Gro

- Resources about organic fertilizers and pest control can be found online or at the local public library. However, fellow gardeners are often the best resource

Conserve Water

- Use mulches, such as hay, wood chips, and compost, whenever possible
- Pay attention while filling your watering can and remember to turn off the water source
- Hoses may not be left unattended at any time
- Sprinklers and underground water systems are not permitted

Gates

- Keep the gates open while in the garden and actively invite curious community members to come explore and answer inquiries about how to join
- Lock the gates when you leave the garden

Respect Each Other

- Do not harvest from other people's plot without permission
- Return all communal gardening supplies cleaned and to their proper location
- Place rolled up hoses back on the spigot

Be Fair With the Land

- There is a waitlist for plots
- Only the Garden Manager may give out plots
- Plots may not be transferred by current members to family/friends upon termination of membership

Tend Your Plot

- If you go on vacation, ask a fellow gardener or friend to care for your plot
- Tidy your plot for the winter by removing dead plants and planting a cover crop
- Untended plots will be reassigned by the Garden Manager following due notification

Come to Work Days and Garden Meetings

- Work days will be scheduled throughout the season
- Notification of select workdays and meetings will be given by email or phone
- Tell the Garden Manager if you move or change your phone number

Know the Rules

- The Garden Manager will contact you if she believes you are in breach of the above-listed rules
- The Winooski Community Garden retains the right to terminate membership at any time
